FINE GAMEROOM FURNITURE

The solid, kiln-dried hardwood used in all California House products is nature's work of art, which means variations in color and grain patterns are normal and should be expected. Please keep in mind that you are purchasing genuine wood furniture, not a product made from veneer or plastic.

Our finishing team carefully hand-applies multiple layers of colors, sealers, and topcoats to achieve the final finish. The maple finish board shown below demonstrates the possible color variations that may occur with each finish, depending on the natural tone of the underlying wood.



WOODS:

Most of the orders we produce are crafted from solid maple. We offer a variety of finish colors on maple (as shown above), along with optional treatments, like distressing and glazing, that can be applied to these finishes.

In addition to maple, we also work with black walnut, northern red oak, and rustic white oak.

FINISHES:

After applying multiple layers of color to the wood, we apply two coats of vinyl sealer to lock out moisture and stabilize the wood. Once the sealer is sanded smooth, we spray on two coats of pre-catalyzed lacquer as the final topcoat. We specify a 30 sheen for the topcoat, resulting in a smooth satin finish that strikes a perfect balance between matte and glossy.
